A general supply list for each class is listed below. Each teacher will provide a specific class/subject supply list once school begins.

PRESCHOOL, PRE-K & JR. -K - THE LITTLE CAMPUS (TLC) STUDENTS:

- Full Change of Clothes (labeled and extra underwear in a Ziploc bag)
- Sleeping pillow & blanket (labeled, taken home to clean on Fridays)
- Backpack (optional)
- Lunch Container Labeled with First and Last Name on the outside. Daily nutritious Nut Free snack & lunch (No sweets).
- After school snack for aftercare children (Nut Free, no sweets)
- Water bottle labeled with name
- Closed-toed shoes
- Pre-toilet ready students - diapers and wipes (regular and flushable)
- Toys from home are highly discouraged, they can get lost or broken
- Note from the Doctor (Well Child Check Up) and shot record

PRE-1ST - 8TH GRADE – ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE CAMPUS GENERAL:

For All School Age Students - Elementary Campus and Middle School (www.classbundl.com)

- Backpack
- Daily nutritious Nut Free snack & lunch
- After school snack (Nut Free)
- Water bottle labeled with name
- Closed-toed shoes

School Supplies: Remember a teacher may require additional supplies :

- 2 pocket type folders (2 - 4 folders)
- #2 pencils (optional)
- Crayons (16 max, Pre-1st, optional)
- Scissors (optional)
- 7-10 book covers for all text books
- Pink Eraser
