Our students will be very well served with the experience, training, and subject specific knowledge each teacher has to share. Each faculty member will be delivering a rigorous curriculum with the appropriate depth and breadth each class deserves. Ms. Hayes is continuing as the Fifth and Sixth grade humanities and language arts teacher. Ms. Leonard is continuing as the Math, Pre-Algebra and Algebra teacher. Mrs. Caviglia is excited to continue teaching the Seventh and Eighth grade Language Arts and History classes. Mr. Zunino is continuing as the Science teacher and S.T.E.M. teacher.

Students need to bring their own technology device such as a Chrome Book, or a laptop. We will have a few rental Chrome Books available. Students will continue to learn Google Classroom skills. STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) curriculum introduces and excites students for careers in science and technology. Ms. Reid is continuing as the Art teacher, Ms. Baran will begin a Middle School Theater program. Mrs. Keppelmann is offering Spanish 1 and Spanish 2, using a new methodology, TPRS. We are happy to welcome Mr. Aitchison as the Athletic Director and P.E. instructor. Middle School students will have electives to choose for the year. The Middle School is fortunate to have such an incredible staff assembled with great talent, a passion for teaching, and a love for their specialties.

Fourth grade through Eighth grade students are invited to attend Project Discovery at Sky Tavern. Our trip will be on August 31st and September 1st.
